- Why were the disciples surprised when Jesus told them to share their food? If you were a disciple there, do you think you would have believed the loaves and fishes could feed so many? Jesus shows us here that we must be ready to share whatever we have with others.
- Can you remember what Jesus did with the bread? The story says he 'blessed it and broke it' before sharing it with the crowds. At what part of Mass do we hear those words? Does it remind you of another story of Jesus?
- We hear each week at Mass how Jesus blesses bread and breaks it. Just as Jesus fed thousands that day, this story reminds us that today Jesus continues to feed millions through the power of God's spirit.
- How do you think the disciples felt as they gave out the loaves and fishes? What a sight it would have been to be there that day!
