FROM YOUR PARISH PRIEST

The week of the parish mission is finally upon us and I would like to take this opportunity to extend a very warm welcome to Fr John Hemer and Fr Royston Price who will be celebrating the Masses and preaching today and indeed, leading the mission over the next few days. I am very grateful to them for being with us and I look forward the many blessings and graces that I know we will receive as a parish during the course of the next week.

So what will the Fathers be talking about to us over the next few evenings? They are going to be addressing a wide range of subjects and topics and I think it might be useful to share a few thoughts with you on why each of these subjects is so important.

On Monday, the feast of St Thomas the Apostle, the theme of the mission service will be *Doubting Thomas and our faith*. Faith is a supernatural gift from God that is given to all of us that allows us to believe all that God has revealed about Himself. How we respond to this gift and how we nurture it is up to us. The notion of faith is becoming more and more unfashionable and unpopular in our world today and the sad and detrimental effects of this are obvious to see. This talk will address doubt and faith in a world that is naturally sceptical.

On Tuesday, the theme of the mission service will be *death and eternal life*. Death is, of course, something that will come to us all at some point but it what happens after death that is most important. We have only one life to live and it is the choices that we make during our time on Earth that will determine whether we spend eternity in heaven or hell. This talk will address these topics that are of vital importance to us all.

On Wednesday, the theme of the mission service will be *Our Lady*. It is only right that in this parish, dedicated to the Mother of God, that we spend an evening reflecting on the wonderful gift that the Lord has given us in his Holy Mother. Mary is the first among the saints in heaven and intercedes ceaselessly on our behalf with her divine son. A devoted love of Our Lady is essential for a healthy spiritual life and this talk will explore our relationship with the Queen of Heaven.

On Thursday, the theme of the mission service will be *The Eucharist*. When the bread and wine are consecrated during the Mass, they truly become the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity Our Lord Jesus Christ. This is not a symbol or a sign but a reality that we must never tire of celebrating. The roots of this Sacrament can be traced far back into the Old Testament and this talk will address this central mystery of our Catholic religion.

On Friday, the theme of the mission service will be *The Love of God*. During this month dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, we will do well to remember that God has created us out of love and for love. The only reason that we exist is to share in the Father's life and to be beacons of His love for others.

Please attend as much of the parish mission as you can and encourage family and friends to come along too. I hope and pray that this will be a time a great growth and renewal for all of us.
