# PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO POLAND MAY 2020

Every two years, as a Parish, we offer the opportunity to go on Pilgrimage. So next year we are planning to visit Poland. Northern Star Travel Ltd come highly recommended and are offering return flights Leeds/Bradford – Krakow. Included in the price is a 6 night's dinner, bed & breakfast in the Metropolo Hotel Krakow.

A very interesting itinerary is being developed and Fr Martin will lead the Pilgrimage. A Northern Star Travel rep and a local guide will be accompanying the group (with all entrance fees included).

The itinerary will include: a guided tour of Krakow, a trip to the Bishop's Palace; we will see places where St John Paul served his priestly and episcopal ministries; this will include a trip to his home town of Wadowice, we will visit The Divine Mercy Chapel in Lagiewniki and there will be a talk by one of the sisters; we travel to Czestochowa (the major Marian shrine in Poland) we will visit the Benedictine Abbey in Tyniec and the famous Salt Mines following the Pilgrims route; there will also be an opportunity to visit to the concentration camp Auschwitz Birkenau.

Fr Martin will celebrate Mass every day throughout the Pilgrimage.

Sufficient time will also be made available for free social time or rest and relaxation.

Pilgrimage will begin on Monday 11th May and returns on Sunday 17th May. The cost of the Pilgrimage is £735pp which includes airport taxes and transfers to / from the airport with St Alban's being the pickup and drop off point. Additional charges will apply for Single room supplement £165.00 and Travel insurance £47.00 per person no age limit, (if these are required). A £200 deposit will need to be paid when you submit your booking.

Booking Forms with the full itinerary can be obtained from from Caroline Walsh (0782 6818872) or if required can be left in an envelope for you at the back of Church. All pilgrims will need to complete a booking form and send it to Northern Star Travel Ltd. We require at least 20 pilgrims to make the trip viable.
