PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO POLAND MAY 2020

Next year we are planning to visit Poland. The itinerary will include: a guided tour of Krakow, a trip to the Bishop's Palace to see where St John Paul served, a trip to his home town of Wadowice and visit The Divine Mercy Chapel in Lagiewniki. We travel to Czestochowa and the Benedictine Abbey in Tyniec and the famous Salt Mines following the Pilgrims route; there will also be an opportunity to visit to the concentration camp Auschwitz Birkenau. Fr Martin will celebrate Mass every day throughout the Pilgrimage. Sufficient time will also be made available for free social time or rest and relaxation.

Pilgrimage will begin on Monday 11th May and returns on Sunday 17th May. The cost of the Pilgrimage is £735pp which includes airport taxes and transfers to / from the airport with St Alban's being the pickup and drop off Additional charges will apply for Single room point. supplement £165.00 and Travel insurance £47.00 per person no age limit, (if these are required). A £200 deposit will need to be paid when you submit your booking.

Booking Forms with the full itinerary can be obtained from Caroline Walsh (0782 6818872). All pilgrims will need to complete a booking form and send it to Northern Star Travel Ltd. We require at least 20 pilgrims to make the trip viable.
