Jesus said to them, 'The people you call sinners will enter the Kingdom of God before any of you because they listened and believed what John the Baptist told them. You would not listen and believe and your hearts have not changed.'

Respond Together...

- Díd the older son do what his father wanted right away? At first he chose to do what he wanted and not what was right. Then he had a change of heart and set to work in the vineyard.
- What did the second son do? At first he agreed to work but then he chose to ignore what his father had said and do what he wanted to do instead.
- Why did Jesus compare the older son with the people that the high priests called sinners? The sinners Jesus was talking about were people who had done the wrong thing but then listened to John the Baptist's teachings and realized that they were wrong, just like the older son did.
- Why were the high priests like the second son? The high priests heard John the Baptist's message but did not listen. They weren't willing to admit they had done wrong and they weren't ready to ask God for forgiveness.
- What is the message from this parable? Even if we make the wrong choices, God will always give us a second chance and will welcome us into his Kingdom.

<u>Pray Together...</u> Lord, when I have choices to make, help me to choose the right path. Help me to do the right thing, to say the right thing and to be the best person I can be. Amen.
