Listen Together...

Listen to this week's scripture, from the Gospel according to Matthew...

Jesus said to his disciples, 'Listen to me.: Whatever you accept on earth will be accepted in heaven and whatever you forbid on earth will be forbidden in heaven. When two of you together agree to ask for something, then God will answer your prayers. For I tell you that when two or three of you meet together in my name, then I will be there with you.'

Respond Together...

- How many people are sitting with you now? When you are at school, how many of you are gathered together? When we are normally at Children's Liturgy during Mass, how many of us come together?
- Do you think that when you are gathered with people at home, at school and at church, that the Holy Spirit is with you all? Jesus told us that when a few are gathered in his name then he will be with them.
- Why is it good for us to come together to pray? When we come together we are together as God's family and Jesus is amongst us. We can pray together and know that God will answer our prayers.
- Sometimes we don't have to be together and say our prayers out loud. Sometimes we can sit in silence with others, sometimes we can sing and sometimes we can just listen to music. All of these are types of prayer and are important because we are sharing in them together.

<u>Pray Together...</u> Dear God, we know that when we come together you are with us. Please listen to the prayers that we bring before you as one family in your name. Amen.
