
## Sunday 20th June 2021 Lord of the wind and sea

- Imagine setting off in a small fishing boat and suddenly finding yourself caught in a terrible storm. How would you feel?
- Violent storms can often come on suddenly in the Sea of Galilee and although some of the disciples were used to being on the water, this storm was so bad that they were afraid they would drown.
- The disciples didn't have any life jackets or radios and flares to help them like they would have today. They were alone on the water. Who did they turn to in the middle of their fear and worry? They turned to Jesus.
- What did Jesus do? He commanded the wind and the sea to be quiet and the disciples caught a glimpse of the power of the Son of God.
- What does this story teach us? In times of fear or trouble in our lives, we can always turn to Jesus and ask for his help. We know that the power of Jesus can overcome all things. Just as Jesus calmed the sea and the wind, so he will calm our worries and bring peace to our lives.
