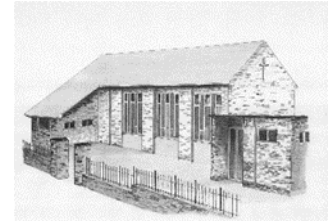

## **MEETING FOR EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS AND NEW VOLUNTEERS**

As the COVID restrictions continue to ease it is important to reinstate full pastoral care for the sick and elderly in the Parish, particularly the reception of Holy Communion in their home. In preparation for this, there will be a meeting for all Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (i.e. Eucharistic Ministers) and for anyone wishing to be part of this vital and important ministry.

This will involve regular home visits bringing Our Blessed Lord in Holy Communion (subject to each volunteer's capacity and availability).

As such, our Parish Safeguarding Policies dictate the need for a DBS check with the help of Clare O'Neil, our Parish Safeguarding Coordinator.

An induction meeting will take place at St Alban's Hall on Tuesday 17th August at 7.30 (after the 7pm Mass)

## **FURTHER EASING OF COVID RESTRICTIONS**

I would ask that people respect the restrictions that remain in place for the safety of everyone and recognising that many people are still very nervous and they should be able to attend church without that being exacerbated by unthinking behaviour.

**FACE MASKS:** : From Tuesday (10 August) it is no longer necessary to wear masks in church, **though parishioners should feel free to do so if they wish.**

**SOCIAL DISTANCING:** As you enter St Mary's, the benches on the right (organ side) will remain as they are with social distancing in place. The benches on the left can all be used with no social distancing.

**HAND SANITISING:** Please **continue** to use the hand sanitising gel as you enter and leave church.

**BOOKING SYSTEM:** It is no longer necessary to book for Mass.

**HOLY COMMUNION:** Those on the left side of church should make their way to the altar gates to receive Holy Communion. Those who are socially distancing on the right will have Holy Communion brought to them as is the present practice.

**SINGING:** Congregational singing is now permitted.

I will produce hymn sheets for each Sunday in the coming weeks so that hymn books do not have to be used.

### **ST ALBAN'S CHURCH**

St Alban's Church will be open for Mass on Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday **evening.**

Social Distancing cannot be guaranteed at any Masses at St Alban's.

### **GIANNA PROJECT (CATHOLIC CARE)**

St Mary's and St Alban's have been supporting the great work which goes on across the Diocese by Gianna Project (Catholic Care) for nearly three years now.

As a reminder, the Gianna Project supports pregnant women, girls & their families.

The project, which has been named after an Italian Saint, Saint Gianna Beretta Molla, was set up in 2011 and it has grown considerably over the past ten years. Workers meet families who need additional support with the arrival of a new baby in their family, with some of these families living in our Halifax community, including an increasing number of refugees.

There is a continuing need for baby (under one year old) accessories including clothes, nappies, baby wipes, etc. As usual a Moses basket will be left at the back of St Mary's for the next two weekends for the collection of your generous donations.
